- 2. Donations for 2019 totaled \$24,666.87 and that for 2020, \$30,114.54. This represents 22 % increase from 2019 to 2020.
- 3. There is a 25.4% increase in closing bank balance.
- 4. Rental is for MAPM's main P.O. Box 236, Elk River, MN 55330. Rental increased from \$92 to \$106.
- 5. Total expenses increased by 25% between 2019 and 2020 CBB expenses being the main contributor.
- 6. \$15.54 in tithes were received for 2020 from Offenders and \$7.77 in 2019.
